1. Summary

This report presents a summary of feedback received during the public consultation process used to gather ideas on how outdoor areas around the SUB could be used. This includes the outdoor areas between Wesbrook Mall, Student Union Blvd, East Mall and University Blvd. Participant feedback will help inform the program planning that is taking place as part of the redesign process for these areas. There were three public consultation activities that took place:

1. An online AMS Clubs questionnaire which ran from June 18 to July 18;
2. An ideas booth at the Student Administration Commission (SAC) Wine and Cheese on September 11; and
3. An Ideas Fair which ran from September 22 to October 10 online, with an in person public event on October 2.

Campus and Community Planning (C+CP) coordinated with the AMS on the first two activities and provided notification of the Ideas Fair in mid- September to early October to over **61,044 contacts** through advertising, and outreach to stakeholders. Notification was sent to **40 campus stakeholders**, representing students, faculty, staff, Student Housing and Hospitality Services, UBC faculties and departments. As a result of these outreach activities:

- A total of **200** people participated at the Ideas Fair event
- **54** completed online questionnaires were received from the Ideas Fair and 4 questionnaires from AMS Clubs during the summer
- A total of **312** ideas were submitted during the Ideas Fair (including 34 ideas received at the SAC event)
- **405** unique page views to the Ideas Fair page on the C+CP website

1.1. Summary of Consultation Feedback

Consultation participants provided a wide variety of ideas on the types of activities they would like to see happening at the outdoor area around the SUB. The ideas submitted ranged from topics related to: art and installations, events and festivals, community gardens, food and markets, outdoor furniture, performance spaces, sports, and design ideas for the areas.

Participants also voted on preferred activities. The activities that received the highest votes included *concerts, outdoor movies, hammocks, art installations and an ideas wall.*

Detailed participant feedback is described below and all verbatim responses are included in Appendix III of this report.

2. Overview of the Consultation Process

UBC is in the process of redesigning the outdoor areas between Wesbrook Mall, Student Union Blvd, East Mall and University Blvd. This area includes MacInnes Field, the areas around the new pool, the existing SUB, Alumni Centre and the Nest (new SUB). This area is informally the social heart of our

campus. Campus and Community Planning (C+CP) organized consultation activities to seek students' ideas and input on how they would like to use the outdoor spaces in this area. Participant feedback will help inform the program planning that is taking place as part of the redesign process for these areas.¹

Participants were asked to submit ideas and their preferences for potential activities that can take place in these areas. There were several public consultation activities that took place:

1. An online AMS Clubs questionnaire which ran from June 18 to July 18;
2. An ideas booth at the Student Administration Commission (SAC) Wine and Cheese on September 11; and
3. An Ideas Fair which ran from September 22 to October 10 online, with an in-person public event on October 2, which was held at the plaza outside the Bookstore on University Boulevard.

3. Stakeholder Engagement and Public Notification

3.1. Public Notification

C+CP provided notification between September 22 to October 10 to **over 61,044** contacts through advertising, email and stakeholder outreach. Notification was provided through the following print advertisements and online channels:

- The Ubyyssey, on September 18 and 25 (circ 12,000 x 2)
- The C+CP event calendar (51 unique pages views)
- The C+CP e-newsletter (circulation 2,060)
- Campus digital signage (3000/day X 11 = 33,000)
- C+CP website - project webpage (405 unique page views)
- Posts to C+CP Twitter accounts between to September 22 to October 10 (over 1,488 followers)
- Emails to stakeholders (40)
- AMS Student Clubs and Constituents (over 370 AMS student clubs and 58, 284 constituents)²
- CiTR 101.9 FM- Live Broadcast (two million listeners)³

3.2. Stakeholder Notification

Notification for the Ideas Fair event was sent to **40** stakeholders, representing AMS, student clubs, faculties, and staff (see Appendix II for the full stakeholder notification list). The communication included a rendering of the area under design and a link to the Campus + Community Planning (C+CP) website to direct people to more information. Stakeholders were encouraged to share the information

with their networks. In addition, C+CP worked with AMS to identify **13** student clubs that are most likely to use the outdoor spaces. An online questionnaire was sent to these clubs to get the feedback from the club representatives.

4. Public Consultation

Students were the primary target audience for the consultation but others were not precluded from participating. There were 3 different consultation opportunities:

1. 13 AMS student clubs were sent a questionnaire on June 18 and were asked to complete it by July 18, during which **4 questionnaires** were submitted.
2. C+CP attended the Student Administration Commission (SAC) Wine and Cheese on September 11 and set up an Ideas Booth.
3. Public consultation ran from September 22 to October 10, during which an Ideas Fair was held on October 2nd. During this consultation **54 online questionnaires** were submitted and **200 people** attended:

4.1. AMS Club Questionnaire

13 student clubs mostly likely to use outdoor spaces for club activities were identified by AMS and C+CP staff. An email was sent out to these clubs with a link to an AMS Club Questionnaire. In the questionnaire, we asked student clubs the types of outdoor activities their members undertake on campus and the space needs for their activities. The four responses we received were incorporated in the analysis in the report.

4.2. Student Administration Commission (SAC) Wine and Cheese

An ideas booth was held during the Student Administrative Commission (SAC) Wine and Cheese, Thursday, September 11:

- 6pm – 8pm at the Student Union Building, 6138 Student Union Boulevard.

C + CP staff were invited to The Student Administrative Commission (SAC) Wine and Cheese to promote the upcoming Ideas Fair, answer questions and ask students to submit their ideas for outdoor activities.

Two display boards were set up with information including an overview of the area under redesign and a blank display board for participants to post their ideas of outdoor activities they would like to see happening. Students were invited to write their ideas on sticky notes and post them on the blank display board.

4.3. Ideas Fair

An Ideas Fair was held on Thursday, October 2:

- 10am – 2pm at the Bookstore Plaza, on the north side patio on University Boulevard.

The Ideas Fair was an interactive exhibit targeting students but open to all. During the event, participants provided input on the types of outdoor activities they would like to see happening in the outdoor areas around the SUB. A series of ten display boards were set up with information and renderings on

- The overall area under design
- The draft designs of the University Commons⁴, the Green, New MacInnes Field, and The Bosque
- 18 images of ideas for outdoor activities
- A blank display board for participants to post their ideas of other outdoor activities they would like to see happening

Copies of the display boards are included in Appendix I.

Similar to the SAC Wine and Cheese, participants were invited to write their ideas on sticky notes and post them on the blank display board. Participants were also given dot stickers to indicate the outdoor activities they prefer or like. Participants were given an unlimited number of stickers to vote with and placed their votes on both the images of ideas as well as on the ideas posted by other participants.

C+CP staff were on hand to answer questions about the proposed design of the area for the duration of the Ideas Fair.

Over **200** people attended the Ideas Fair.

4.4. Online Consultation

As part of the online consultation, the C+CP website provided the same information as was available at the Ideas Fair on October 2nd. The web content was posted on the C+CP website on September 22nd, and the link to the online questionnaire was also posted on the Public Consultation page on September 22nd. The online questionnaire included links to the relevant supporting information on the C+CP website. The online questionnaire included the same 18 images of activities on the display boards for voting as well as space for respondents to list additional ideas.

The public was invited to take the questionnaire and provide input until October 10. **54** online questionnaires were submitted.

5. Detailed Feedback

Below is a summary of the ideas received by those who participated at the various events.⁵ All the ideas were reviewed and votes were tallied for each of the ideas. Ideas were organized by the number of votes placed on each of the ideas to get a sense of the preferred activities. The full list of ideas received, along with the number of votes received is included in Appendix III.

The goal of the voting exercise was to provide a general sense of preferred outdoor activities for these areas, particularly student preferences. The voting method and the analysis of the data were not designed to be carried out as a scientific process. As a result, there may be certain biases that influenced the voting outcomes. For example, the outdoor activities that received the highest votes are the activities that C+CP provided photos for as part of the display boards.

Overall, **312 ideas** were submitted and **2,184 votes** were placed across all ideas presented on the display boards and online in combination with those submitted by participants. The bulk of the ideas were received during the Ideas Fair event. The ideas submitted ranged from topics related to: art and installations, events and festivals, community gardens, food and markets, outdoor furniture, performance spaces, sports, and design ideas for the areas. From a planning and design perspective, the ideas fell into three categories:

- Fixed: Activities that require a specific location that is permanent
- Non-fixed: Activities that could take place in a variety of locations
- Either: Activities which locations are flexible, depending on how they are implemented

The tables below include the top 15 overall ideas as well as the top 3 ideas for specific spaces in the area. The percentage of votes is calculated over 2,184, the total votes submitted by participants.

7. Next Steps

C+CP staff are currently determining how the space may accommodate some of these activities. In particular, staff are determining the feasibility of a range of 'fixed' activities, as these will have to be planned for as part of the designs. All ideas submitted by participants are being considered, not just those with the highest votes. Several ideas put forward by participants are already a part of the design plans or other projects, including:

- AMS BBQ, Storm the Wall, Block Party and the UBC Farmer's Market Stand.
- A roof top garden on top of the Nest
- Space for temporary installations at the Money & Raymond M.C. Lee Square, located outside the bookstore near the new Alumni Centre
- Space for small or informal concerts and performances at the New MacInnes Field
- A variety of table and chairs at various spaces in the area are planned
- Routers and electrical outlets are incorporated into the site plans
- Sheltered bike racks are being incorporated into the building designs for the area.

A couple ideas put forward were related to bike lanes and parking on campus. These ideas are actively being pursued for the campus but fall outside the scope of this specific project.

Many of the ideas submitted are program related or "non-fixed" and will not be constrained by the designs for these areas. These ideas, in theory, can take place anywhere in these areas. There is however a need for a champion to implement these ideas. All ideas received will be shared with the AMS, GSS, UBC REC and VP-Students office. These groups may be interested in championing some of the ideas or passing them on to others who may be interested.

The final designs for these areas will be made over the next few years, as each of these projects move forward. The University Commons area is the first area that will be redesigned. Project construction for University Commons is scheduled to begin this winter.

The feedback collected in this consultation may also be used to help inform programming and design considerations for other areas on campus that are undergoing public realm improvements in the future.
